Dear Parent/Carer

Following our letter in November I wanted to clarify the exeat arrangements for the Sixth Form. Exeat provides students with the opportunity to conduct independent learning at home or to pursue other enrichment activities which will support their academic development. This arrangement means that students will be able to leave school from lunchtime, if they do not have a Period 5 or 6 lesson, or from break, if they do not have a lesson after period 2.

To take advantage of this privilege, students must attend morning registration and remain on the school premises until either the end of Period 2 or 4, regardless of whether they have free study periods during the day. This is in the interest of safeguarding students' health and safety.

Students with C3 detentions will also be expected to remain at school on a Friday to complete their detention. Furthermore, some students may be asked to remain on site, following staff recommendations and/or due to attainment concerns, to benefit from supervised study sessions.

If a student has low attendance, punctuality issues or truants a lesson their exeat privileges will be withdrawn until there is an improvement.

If your child must leave school at another point within the day they must speak with their PPM to have an exit slip completed. If this is not completed your child will not be permitted to leave the school premises.
