## **Dear Parents and Carers**

I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for study leave (this is the suspension of compulsory registration with Form Tutors). Although traditionally, study leave would mean lessons are suspended, we have decided that some lessons will continue in this period and students are expected to attend.

Claremont High School Academy has made a commitment to the teaching and learning of the Sixth Form over this period. Some staff may decide to continue lessons during this period, and will inform students of these arrangements. On days they have examinations they may well find it easier to revise for that subject at home before the exam but on other days they should make full use of the available staff time and school facilities for study.

- Year 13 students to continue with registration and lessons until Friday 19<sup>th</sup> May
- BTEC students are expected to attend all lessons but will not be required to attend registration
- Book return day for all students Monday 26<sup>th</sup> June

In a number of subjects, such as Languages, Maths, Sciences and subjects with pre-release examination material, regular practice and repetition of questions helps reinforce learning. In other subjects, such as the Humanities, Sociology, Psychology, Business and Economics, students find that as they near the end of their studies they are more successful in composing a synoptic answer drawing on all aspects of the subject but they need effective teacher feedback on what they have produced with identification of areas for development.
