SCHOOL UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

All pupils in Years 7 to 11 are expected to wear the full school uniform, as outlined in this leaflet. The Governing Body of the school unanimously supports the school uniform policy.

Government guidelines on behaviour and discipline state that where a pupil continually fails to comply with school uniform regulations, he or she may face serious disciplinary action. Please ensure your child is correctly dressed in full school uniform at all times, otherwise you will be contacted and your child will be sent home to change.

In particular please note the following:

- Blazers must be worn at all times
- Overcoats/Jackets must be plain black or navy blue. No denim
- Trainers should only be worn in P.E. lessons
- No hooded tops, caps or hats to be worn on school premises
- Hobble or split skirts are not to be worn
- Jewellery is not permitted, except for a watch, a single pair of stud earrings
- Make-up may not be worn
- All items of clothing should be clearly marked with a name-tag
- Uniform to be worn in an appropriate manner

The School Uniform

SHIRTS	Plain White or Pale Blue Denim and cotton denim shirts, T-shirts and Polo shirts are NOT permitted. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
JUMPER	Navy-Blue 'V' neck No pattern or motif on jumper. Must be plain 'V' neck
BLAZER	Navy-Blue with embroidered badge Must be worn at all times
TIE	College colour Only available from school shop
TROUSERS SKIRT	Navy-Blue, traditional, regulation style Girls may wear either, Skirts must be knee-length – No split/hobble skirts
SOCKS	Navy, Black or white
TIGHTS	Navy, Black or Natural Over-the-knee socks are not permitted
SHOES	Sensible plain black leather Boots or trainers are not permitted No high-heels or wedges
OVERCOAT / JACKET	Must be plain Black or Navy-Blue for outdoor use – they should not be worn in lessons or in the school buildings. Denim or leather are not permitted. No large motif or design. No fashion coats, e.g. ankle length, quilted.
HATS, CAPS and HOODIES	Hats, including baseball caps, are not allowed or to be worn in school.
JEWELLERY	A watch and small stud earrings only.
KEY CHAINS	No chains to be brought to school in the interests or Health and Safety
SCHOOL BAG	Available from Jackies All pupils should have a suitable bag large enough to carry Their text books, exercise books and PE kit.

Equipment and PE Kit

Equipment

Every student is expected to provide the following basic items of equipment for every lesson :

Black or blue ballpoint pen (and a spare!)	-	Pencil
Pencil eraser, pencil sharpener	-	Ruler 12" / 30 cm
Coloured pencils / fine fibre tips	-	Calculator
Protractor, set square, pair of scissors	-	Rough notebook / jotter

Tippex / Liquid Paper, or other correction aid, is not allowed in school and must not be used in any school work.

Textbooks and specialised equipment will be issued on loan and students will be required to pay for any loss or damage to school property.

P.E. Kit

BOYS : Years 8-11

Trainers – non marking
White socks (*not the same pair as worn the rest of the day*)
Plain-Blue shorts (*standard length*)
White T-shirt or polo shirt with Claremont motif *

Outdoor kit

Trainers, Football Boots and Shin-Pads
Royal-Blue long socks with Amber top *
Amber shorts (*standard length*)
Blue Rugby top – reversible – Amber stripe on inside *
Gum Shield (*for Rugby and Hockey*)
Plain Blue 2-piece tracksuit with Claremont motif * (*Optional*)
It is also recommended to bring a spare, plain-white T-Shirt or Vest to wear under the Blue Rugby top during the winter months

Reversible blue football/rugby top with yellow side panelling and Claremont motif
Black shorts
Plain black football socks
Football boots/Astroturf trainers
Shin pads
Gum shield for rugby
Towel for showers (*optional*)
Blue Claremont tracksuit (*optional*)

GIRLS: Year 7

Indoor and Outdoor kit

White polo shirt with Claremont motif
Blue Claremont tracksuit
Trainers
Towel for showers (*optional*)

GCSE / BTEC P.E. Students

Black polo shirt with white piping and Claremont logo. Student's initials on the shirt.
Black Shorts - Plain black football socks - White sports socks (short)
- Blue Claremont tracksuit or plain blue jogging bottoms.
